

Week beginning 21<sup>st</sup> January

## English

At the beginning of the week we continued to learn about contractions. Last week we used an app to record how some objects were feeling but this week we wrote a letter from the objects expressing their feelings.

At the end of the week we began learning about comparative language, focusing on words that we use to compare objects and end in 'er' or 'est'. We had objects on the table and we had to find words to compare them, e.g. bigger, smaller, shortest.



Later in the week we watched clips of world record attempts and then decided what world records our class could attempt.



## Maths

First we learnt how to add a 2 digit number to another 2 digit number by using a structured number line and then progressed to solving the number sentence by using a blank number line.

## Science

We are beginning to learn about different types of birds, we spent the afternoon observing the birds in our school environment. We had to be very quiet!

## Music

The Badgers progressed to using instruments this week. We all chose an instrument and then in groups composed a short sequence of 8 beats before performing to the class.

## Computing

The owls continued with lightbot but this week we learnt how to group algorithms into smaller parts.

## PE

On Wednesday we continued with a gym lesson, learning how to put a sequence of gym movements together and performing them, initially on a mat before moving to the bench.



On Thursday we went outside and learnt the next stage of tag rugby.
