Maths

- This week in maths we have been looking at mass/weight.
- The children used some scales to weigh a variety of items from around the classroom. They then had to record which item was heavier and which was lighter.

Phonics

- In phonics we have been looking at 's' and 'es' endings and how to change a word from singular to plural.

History

- In history we have been learning about Mary Anning.
- The children listened to a story about her, watched a short video clip and looked at pictures of her discoveries.
- The children had an opportunity to look at some fossils and some tools that are used to find and collect fossils.
- In groups the children took on roles and acted out what they had learned about Mary, her family and people she knew.

Science

- In science we have been looking at plants and how important light is to plants. The class placed 6 plants in different places around the school, each having a different amount of light. We left them there for two weeks and then recorded our findings.
