Maths

This week we have been practising how to solve mixed mathematical problems (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and we have had to be very observant when noticing what calculation symbol is used. We solved our problems with either blank number lines or drawing dienes.

English

We began the week revisiting what 'conjunctions' and 'contractions' are.
