

Hi everyone

Thank you! Once again you have come up trumps. Many thanks to all of you who have revised your requests - it has definitely helped and we are now in a position where we can accommodate all those who have asked for places - although years 1 and 2 are nearing the maximum limit on some days. So if you have sent your form in already please assume you have the places you asked for.

Year R children will need to queue in a socially distanced way outside the Ladybirds classroom. Mrs Halbauer will work on a Monday, Mrs Philipson will work on a Tuesday and a Wednesday and Mrs Sanger will work Thursday and Friday.

The children picked up brilliantly in the Autumn Term after home learning in the summer and there is no reason to believe this won't happen again. If your child is only in school one or two days a week it would be great if you could cover home learning on the other days.

Every Wednesday is being planned as a less formal day. In addition, on this day the Teachers in KS1 will host a zoom meeting with their class at the following times:
